Thank you for your interest in a scholarship provided by the St. Augustine/Ketterlinus Alumni Association. The funds for these scholarships are supplied by fellow Yellow Jacket alumni with the hope they will enable deserving SAHS graduates to succeed even further in reaching their goals. Scholarships currently available include:

Academic Scholarships (3):

- L. Curtis Westbrook Jr. Scholarship - \$500 (at a minimum), one year only subject to possible renewal
- Terrell G. Davis Scholarship - \$500 (at a minimum), one year only subject to possible renewal
- Carol A. Melton Scholarship - \$500 (at a minimum), one year only subject to possible renewal

Academy Scholarship (1): Student must have been in one of the career academies 3 or more years: Aerospace Academy, St. Johns County Academy of Future Teachers, or The Academy of Law and Homeland Security.

- SA/KHS Alumni Association Academy Scholarship - \$500 non-renewable

Vocational Scholarship (1): Student working towards a vocational diploma or college degree from a technical/postsecondary vocational school or college.

- SA/KHS Alumni Association Way Project Vocational Scholarship - \$1,000, one year only subject to possible renewal
- All possible renewable scholarships mentioned above for academic and vocational scholarships are based on fund availability for the SA/KHS Alumni Association. Award recipients should review in detail any further scholarship renewal information in your packet at Senior Awards Night.

The scholarship committee within the SA/KHS Alumni Association determines the recipients after evaluating qualified applications. Names of the students selected are announced during Senior Award Night.

Complete instructions and a list of required documentation follow.

— ***Applicants must provide all requested material by April 15, 2021.*** —

If, after the selection is made, a recipient fails to graduate with the Class of '21, or if any information provided in the application is found to be false, the scholarship will be awarded to another student or the funds held for future recipients. All funds are paid directly to the college, university, or vocational school the student is attending.

Requirements:

- _____ 1. The application must be typed or printed in ink. Please provide additional pages if more room is needed to fill in information on the application.
- _____ 2. The application must be submitted to the scholarship committee in person or postmarked no later than **April 15, 2021**.
- _____ 3. The applicant must be graduating at the end of the 2020-2021 school year.
- _____ 4. The applicant must show proof of scholastic achievement. A sealed copy of the applicant's high school transcript, issued by the school, must be submitted by the applicant along with the scholarship application.
- _____ 5. The applicant must disclose school involvement and/or work experience (both paid or volunteer).
- _____ 6. The applicant must disclose community-related activities.
- _____ 7. The applicant must provide one (1) written and signed reference of character from an adult (over 21 years of age) non-family member not associated with St. Augustine High School during the 2020-2021 school year. This reference must have known the applicant for at least two years.
- _____ 8. The applicant must provide two (2) St. Augustine High School faculty members (currently on staff) letters of recommendation written on St. Augustine High School letterhead with the original signature of the faculty member.
- _____ 9. The applicant must apply to a state accredited college/university (public or private) or a state accredited vocational school, either of which must be located in the United States.
- _____ 10. The scholarship, if awarded, shall apply to registration, tuition, books, lab fees and/or other special fees required by the college/university or vocational school as described above.
- _____ 11. All of the information provided in or with this application as required shall be considered for this scholarship award. Applications that are deemed incomplete (failure to supply all required information above) will be disqualified. If awarded, the academic and vocational scholarship expires June 30, 2022 and is not transferable. Scholarships may be renewed subject to board approval.
- _____ 12. **All of the above items must be submitted with the scholarship application.**

If the student fails to graduate by the end of the 2020-2021 school year, he/she will not be awarded the scholarship. All decisions are at the discretion of the Alumni Association board of directors.
